P6/7 Learning Journey this Half Term

The children are settling back into school well and I am writing to let you know what we will be up to in the main curriculum areas in the coming weeks.

Numeracy:

- Place Value, Ordering and Rounding
- Pattern, Relationship and Sequences, Function Machines (input, output & rule)
- Money and Percentages
- Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division

Literacy:

- Parts of speech/Word Classes starting with nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs
- Group reading book with relevant language activities and comprehensions
- Creative writing – Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers, Punctuation (VCOP) will be developed to create increasingly complex sentences in tasks such as recounts, letters, explanations and persuasive writing

The World Around Us (WAU):

The Second World War (this topic will continue through the second half of the Autumn Term).

- The Outbreak of War
- Evacuation
- Rationing
- The Role of Women
- Propaganda
- Key Events

The children are already very interested in this topic and I will be encouraging them to ask family members about it. Any insights or family histories about it will be gratefully received.
